GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Candidates who have appeared for the End Semester Examination (ESE) in a particular subject are eligible to apply for the Supplementary Examination in that subject provided
 - > They have scored less than 29 in the ESE (Applicable for Sem V and Sem VII)
 - ➤ The total of Continuous Assessment (CA), Mid Semester Examination (MSE) and End Semester Examination marks is less than 37. *That is, CA+MSE+ESE <37* (Applicable for Sem III)
- ❖ Candidates who have not appeared for the End Semester Examination (ESE) in any particular subject are not eligible to apply for the Supplementary Examination in that subject
- ♦ Eligible candidates are required to fill an examination form and submit to the exam cell. Forms will be available at the Fifth Floor exam cell from Monday, December 29, 2025 to Wednesday, December 31, 2025.
- ♦ The Examination Fee per subject is ₹ 500 (Five hundred rupees only) which should be paid online using the QR code provided.
- ❖ Hall tickets may be collected one hour before the commencement of the first examination
- The Supplementary Examinations will commence from
 - ➤ Monday, January 5, 2026 For SE SEM III (NEP 2020 Autonomy) subjects
 - > Friday, January 2, 2026 For TE SEM V and BE SEM VII (R 19 C Scheme) subjects
- ❖ The schedule will be available on the college website and on the notice board, second floor exam cell about a week before the commencement (from around December 26, 2025)
- An open house (to view the checked answer books of all subjects a candidate has appeared) will be conducted during the third week of January 2026
- ❖ The results of the Supplementary Examinations will be published along with the results of the regular Nov-Dec 2025 End Semester Examinations by the first week of February 2026
