



Memorandum of Understanding

Lunghwa University of Science and Technology (LHU), Taiwan and

Don Bosco Institute of Technology (DBIT), India

Lunghwa University of Science and Technology (Taiwan) and Don Bosco Institute of Technology (India), wishing to enhance friendship relations between the two institutions and to develop academic exchange in the areas of education, research and other activities, enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereafter the "MOU") to memorialize each institution's agreement to cooperate and work together toward strategic and mutually beneficial objectives in Taiwan and India.

The area of cooperation contemplated by this MOU may include any program at either institution, which is felt to be desirable and feasible for the development and strengthening of collaborative relationships between the two institutions. Any program will be subject to mutual consent, availability of resources and funding, and the approval of each university.

Such programs may include, without limitation:

- a. Exchange of students and faculty
- b. 2+2 type degree programs
- c. Short-term summer programs
- d. Joint cultural or research programs

This Agreement shall be effective upon execution by both parties and shall remain in effect for 30 months (2.5 years), and may be renewed at the end of the term upon mutual written consent. The Agreement may also be terminated at any time and for any reason as deemed necessary by either institution with advanced written notification. Termination would not affect students already engaged in the Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Agreement is executed by Lunghwa University of Science and Technology and Don Bosco Institute of Technology (India) to be effective upon the date of last signature below. This document supersedes any prior agreements.
