ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

DBIT follows the provisions of the Anti-ragging circulars of the AICTE, UGC and University of Mumbai. The Management strives to make the campus 'Ragging Free' and deals with complaints very strictly.

- Anti-Ragging committee is formed as per the University guidelines. The names of the committee members along
 with the contact details is displayed in every classroom
- Students are made aware of the provisions of the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 during the orientation as given below:
 - 1. Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.
 - Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any
 educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to
 two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
 - Any student convicted of an offence shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall
 not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such
 dismissal.
 - 4. Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian, or a teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of that educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the Police Station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action.
- The Anti-Ragging committee organises events to make students aware of the harmful effects of ragging
- The Anti-Ragging committee meets regularly to discuss disciplinary issues related to ragging in the campus
- Counsellors will be available on campus to mentor and counsel students affected by ragging
