GAME OF CODES

CSI-DBIT student chapter successfully conducted its annual inter-college online coding competition "Game of Codes" on 6th October 2018 (Saturday). It was conducted under the banner of CSI TechNext India 2019. The technical partner for this event was Hackerearth. Hackerearth provides a platform for organizations with their innovation management and technically recruitment needs by hosting coding competitions, hackathon and programming challenges. The top 3 teams of the final round will be awarded a cash prize of **Rs.7000**, **Rs.5000** and **Rs.3000**. Students participated in three rounds of increasing difficulty in teams of two. Each round was of 1hour duration. Round 1 consisted of 5 questions, Round 2 consisted of 4 questions and the final round consisted of 2 questions. There were 360 participants in 220 teams registered from across 35 colleges. The registered teams were majorly from Mumbai region with a few from outside Mumbai.
